Make a Run-Through Banner

To celebrate 50 or 100 games



Things you'll need

- 2 poles (ask an NJFC committee member to get these from the boiler room)
- Blue and yellow tissue paper or crepe paper (about 2 metres)
- Gold or white paper for the lettering
- Sticky tape (regular width, about 12mm)
- Letter templates PDF
- Cougar logo png
- Cling wrap or plastic bags

Directions

- Work out what message to put on your banner and print out only the relevant letters on gold or white paper using the letters template. For example: CONGRATS MEG 50
- 2. Cut out the letters and one or two cougars logos. Put aside for later.
- 3. Make the banner. The banner will be about 2 metres wide x 2 metres high. Lay out lengths of crepe paper to make the banner, for example alternating blue and yellow stripes.
- 4. Sticky tape the sections of crepe paper together, using 20cm lengths of tape. Don't use long lengths of tape or too much tape it will be too hard to break through.
- 5. Roll the left and right sides of the banner around the poles and secure with tape.
- 6. Glue or roll sticky tape the letters and cougars onto the banner.
- 7. Roll up your banner carefully. Wrap in cling wrap or plastic to keep it dry.
- 8. Banner is ready to run through on game day!
