YJFL FEEDBACK

The YJFL's CEO, Dom Milesi recently emailed clubs to share important reminders, which we pass on:

Club Complaints & Investigations

In recent weeks we have received a number of complaints from clubs on matters as a "fyi". Parents should not be contacting the YJFL directly regarding these matters. We will be directing them to go through their relevant club.

Naturally if there is an incident of a serious nature or one that cannot be resolved clubs are able to lodge a notice of investigation by 4pm on the Wednesday after a game with a bond payment of \$500.

Contact with Umpires

Under By-Law 5.10 Team managers may only approach the Umpires at breaks in play regarding administrative matters, such as ground condition, team sheet compliance or clarification of red/yellow cards. They are not permitted to approach the umpires to discuss umpiring decisions.

No other team official is permitted to approach the umpires during the match.

We have had multiple instances of team managers and/or coaches complaining to umpires about free kick counts during breaks. This is completely unacceptable, especially when over 90% of our umpires are under 18 years of age. Any official noted to have done this in the umpire report will be asked for an explanation and may be asked to appear at the Conduct Investigation Tribunal.

Runners

The conduct of runners has deteriorated again in the last couple of rounds. Once again, we ask coaches to be reminded that runners are only meant to deliver two messages and then come straight off the ground. They are not supposed to stay on the field and coach, nor engage with the opposition. If we see no improvement in runner behaviour in coming weeks the YJFL will consider making By-Law adjustments to either financially sanction clubs breaching the rules or limit the use of runners during matches. Umpires have been encouraged to white card any coach who is using a runner inappropriately.
